Founded in 1856 by the Daughters of Charity, Maryvale began as a haven for orphaned children. Today, the organization stands as a symbol of resilience and innovation—delivering trauma-informed care and wraparound support through a diverse array of programs rooted in compassion and community healing. "Being recognized as a California Nonprofit of the Year by Assemblywoman Rubio is a testament to our long-standing mission and the impact we continue to make. From its campus in Rosemead, California, and program locations in Duarte and South El Monte, Maryvale serves vulnerable communities through:

Early Childhood Education – Building strong foundations for infants, toddlers, and young children through nurturing, high-quality education.

Temporary Housing – Offering safety, stability, and support to unhoused women and children through the Seton House program.

Mental Health Services – Providing counseling and intensive services to families in crisis, helping them heal, grow, and thrive.

Substance Use Treatment – Delivering bilingual outpatient recovery support through Connections by Maryvale for individuals battling addiction.
